#### Dress Rehearsal (1/29) Details:

- Adult act leaders must be present to supervise their group
- All props must be present at the start of the rehearsal
- All performers should be in costume (bathrooms may be used for changing if necessary)
- ALL students should report to the gym right after school, but once their act has performed, students may leave with a designated adult
- Students staying to watch later acts are expected to do so quietly and respectfully, and with a chaperone present
- Consider having students bring a substantial snack and something quiet to occupy them as this is a long afternoon (especially for the groups later in the show)

### Tivoli Rehearsal (2/1) Details:

- Arrive to the Tivoli as quickly as possible after school dismissal (carpooling is recommended due to the limited parking right near the theater)
- Use the theater entrance off of the parking lot on Highland (north of the main theater entrance)
- Adult act leaders must be present to supervise their group
- No props needed at this rehearsal EXCEPT for instrumental acts
- Once their act has performed, students may leave with a designated adult
- Students staying to watch later acts are expected to do so quietly and respectfully, and with a chaperone present
- Students are encouraged to bring a snack to eat while they wait (the theater concession counter is also typically open for the purchase of snacks/beverages during this rehearsal)

# School Show (2/2) Details:

- Adult act leaders must drop off props the morning of February 2<sup>nd</sup> between 8 8:20 AM there will be a table in the entry
- Students should bring any costume pieces to change into after lunch
- This show is for Whittier teachers and students only (sorry, parents!)
- The variety show committee will transport props from the school show to the Tivoli unless otherwise communicated to you.

# Tivoli Show (2/3) Details:

- Performers, emcees, and stage crew members should arrive at 9:15 a.m.
- Performers are to use the theater entrance off of the parking lot on Highland (north of the main theater entrance)
- Parents are to drop students involved in the show off at the door (even the young ones) NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Parents and other audience members may arrive via the main theater entrance beginning at 9:30 a.m. (there is no admission fee!). If you or a member of your party will need accessible seating at the Tivoli, please let us know by Wednesday, January 30<sup>th</sup> (whittiervarietyshow@gmail.com)
- All performers will have designated seats in the theater. Because seating is limited, please do not plan saving a seat for your performer(s)/having your performer(s) sit with you during the act they are not performing in unless you believe they really need to
- The theater concession counter will be open before the show and during intermission for the purchase of snacks/beverages
- Please retrieve all props from the stage at the Tivoli immediately after the show concludes
