

Experiences 101

Volunteer hosts should reach out to the experience committee or executive board with their idea(s) and willingness to host. The committee is happy to give past experience ideas but the ideas come from the experience hosts.

Host families decide the details, time, location and fee (per person or per family), the age range, the maximum attendees. Hosts will be responsible for sending evites, reminders, and updating any changes or rescheduling of date/time/location.

Multiple families can host one experience. The more hosts, the less the cost will be per person.

100% of the fees/cost will be covered by the host(s). The fee charged is considered a donation to the PTA and will not offset the costs for hosting.

It is encouraged that new families host from fundraiser to fundraiser, but anyone is welcome to host the same experience or a new one. But it is not required and there is no pressure for families to be repeat hosts.

Any event themed Father/Daughter or Mother/Son etc. will include the verbiage that all are welcome. Moms, Uncles, friends, Grandpas can attend a Father/Daughter dance – etc.

Parent/child events are strongly encouraged. To alleviate cost and space constraints, please consider hosting primary and intermediate parent child experiences.
