



# FUN FAIR FAQS

## What is the Whittier Fun Fair?

The Fun Fair is a PTA sponsored event for all Whittier students and their immediate families. Please do not bring out of town guests or extended family members, as supplies are limited. You can expect 14 different carnival style games, a book walk (our take on the classic “cake walk”) and a couple other fun activities.

## When is the Fun Fair?

Saturday, February 8 from 2-4 PM (open house format - you can arrive/leave anytime.)

## Where is the Fun Fair?

The Fun Fair will be held at Whittier and games will be located in the Gym, Library, Activity Room and a few classrooms (Vanacora, Miller and Carey).

## Is this a drop off event?

No. Every student must have a parent or adult present to supervise. Please ensure students stay in the areas intended for the Fun Fair and out of other classrooms, etc.

## Will food be available?

Popcorn, cotton candy, dum dums, ring pops and water will be available in the Gym, while supplies last. To be sensitive to those with allergies, do not bring your own snacks or drinks. All food must remain in the Gym.

## How much does it cost?

The entire event (including snacks and prizes) is free.

## Will there be prizes?

We have planned a Classroom Competition, where students will have the opportunity to win tickets when playing games. Tickets should then be deposited into the respective student's classroom collection box. Younger siblings are encouraged to participate and can win tickets to be deposited as well. The top 5 classes with the most tickets will win an extra recess, plus a new board game for their classroom. Otherwise, students will have the opportunity to win a book during the Book Walk and there will be tattoos, stickers and lollipops available in other formats also.
